AVIAN INFLUENZA

On 22 Jan 09, a task was raised in response to a report of an unconfirmed strain of avian influenza on a turkey farm in Abbotsford. Ministry of Agriculture and Lands together with the Canadian Food Inspection Agency initiated a Joint Emergency Operations Centre (JEOC) to manage further sample analysis, quarantine, depopulation and composting of approximately 60,000 turkeys. PEP Southwest Regional Office staff along with TEAMS members are present in the JEOC and are continuing to provide support.
