WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 06 – 12 APRIL 2009

FLOOD

On 10 Apr 09, freshet run-off had to be diverted to protect the drinking water wells in the community of Genelle.

On 11 Apr 09, debris in a drainage ditch along 10 Mile Lake Road in the Cariboo Regional District threatened to cause flooding on an individual's property. A Maintenance Contractor was to check the area and MoT requested permission to remove the debris.

LANDSLIDE

On 08 Apr 09, a potential slope failure was identified in the Cottonwood Canyon on the Fraser River. It was believed that it could potentially cause a blockage of the Fraser Channel, therefore, Ministry of Environment (MOE) advised the Cariboo Regional District to have a Geo Tech attend and provide status of the site. The Cariboo Regional District reported they would be engaging a Geo Tech to perform a site assessment and then report their findings to MOE.
