WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 20 Apr to 26 Apr 2009

ENVIRONMENTAL

On 20 Apr 09 a landslide or debris flow impacted Eagle Bay Road in the Columbia Shuswap Regional District. The road and one vacant residence, along with outbuilding were impacted. 30 plus homes were isolated behind the blockage.

On 22 Apr 09 Cottonwood River was being monitored for a potential flooding situation.

On 22 Apr 09 rising water levels caused a debris flow and bridge closure at Quick Bridge. Some voluntary evacuations occurred and people have since returned home. Two or three homes in the area of Cluculz Lake experienced flooding because of high water levels of the lake and sandbagging was necessary at one residence. Ebenezer Flats on the Bulkley River experienced flooding requiring evacuation of residences. 5 to 10 residences are being monitored.

On 22 Apr 09 Telkwa experienced flooding near Eddy Park on Highway 16.

On 22 Apr 09 the NWE PREOC activated in response to flooding in their region.

On 23 Apr 09 PECC was activated to support PREOCs dealing with flooding in the Province.

On 24 Apr 09 an ice jam on Willow River threatened to flood three homes.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 21 Apr 09 a task was issued to ensure provincial readiness related to Earthquake Exercises.

On 24 Apr 09 incident opened in response to SRI (Severe Respiratory Illness)/Swine Flu event.

On 25 Apr 09 Quesnel and District Highway Rescue responded to assist with a BCAS medical assist for a trapped person.

On 25 Apr 09 ESS – New Westminster responded to assist New Westminster Police with a building that needed to be evacuated following the release of pepper spray.
