BODY RECOVERY

On 9 May 09, Golden SAR responded to the Coroner's request to recover the body of a deceased snowmobiler in the Baird Creek area southwest of Golden.

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 7 May 09, a failure of a pump while jet mixing a tank of sweet crude oil at the Kinder Morgan tank farm in Burnaby was upgraded to Code 2 (Urgent Status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) due to the significant discharge of vapours and odour as well as the potential risk to the environment. Material was contained onsite and continual surveillance of the containment pond was implemented to ensure there was no off-site migration. The Fire Department attended and foamed the area in order to suppress the vapours and air monitoring equipment was established on site. MOE RO & HQ, OGC, EC, PEP Regional Manager & Executive, local government EPC and the Fraser Health Authority were advised and continue to monitor the response and clean up.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 4 May 09, high winds caused a tree to fall on a home in North Vancouver resulting in extensive damage and rendering the house unsafe to occupy. North Vancouver ESS responded and provided coverage for 2 people.
