On 23 Jun, 12 to 15 workers were evacuated from a warehouse in Cranbrook after suffering symptoms of skin irritation, sore lungs, trouble breathing and nausea, following being exposed to a mixture of fertilizer, lubricants and an unknown white powder. Workers were taken to hospital, examined and released shortly thereafter. Disposal teams secured the building and removed the toxic chemicals.
