EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 23 Sep 09, Cowichan SAR responded to assist the RCMP with an evidence search in the Glenora area on 26 Sep.

INTERFACE FIRE

On 23 Sep 09, an interface fire in the Hihium Lake area near Cache Creek threatened 27 summer residents and 7 commercial buildings. The Thompson Nicola Regional District declared a State of Local Emergency and an Evacuation Alert and subsequent Evacuation Order was issued for those at risk.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 21 Sep 09, the Peachland Fire Department were contacted to assist BCAS with access to a patient at the Peachland Campground. They stood down prior to their departure after BCAS managed to walk the individual out.

On 22 Sep 09, the North Fraser Fire Department responded to assist BCAS with a report of an industrial accident involving an overturned backhoe near Lake Errock in the Fraser Valley. The operator of the machinery was recovered deceased.
