WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 26 OCT-01 NOV 2009

FLOODING

On 31 Oct, the Central Coast Regional District activated their EOC to Level 1 in response to flooding in the Bella Coola Valley. Several culverts were blocked, there was debris reported on the highway and a number of residents were cut-off when their roads flooded.

On 31 Oct, some flooding occurred in the Village of Kingcome Inlet due to heavy rain and snowmelt. The river was predicted to rise dramatically and a high tide was due. The situation was monitored and a Coast Guard vessel stood by in case an evacuation of the community became necessary. By early afternoon, the river level dropped and, other than some water on the roadways, severe flooding was averted.

LANDSLIDE

On 30 Oct, two properties in Williams Lake were affected by a land slippage that destroyed a retaining wall. Seven individuals were provided with alternate accommodation until it could be determined if the bank was stable.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 28 Oct, Prince George SAR was requested by the RCMP to assist with an evidence search in the Prince George area. Due to adverse weather the search was postponed until 30 Oct. Nothing was located and RCMP stood the team down.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 01 Nov, the main water intake for the village of Thasis was blocked by excess silt and debris after heavy rains. While crews worked to purge the pipes and restore the original water supply to the village, the Strathcona Regional District arranged a bypass by drafting water from the creek to feed the community and prepared a boil water advisory.
